How

How to get there:

By plane

Your destination airport is Salzburg Airport. Please note that international flights (from the USA, Asia, Australia, etc.) are usually routed either via Vienna or Frankfurt.

By train

Your target station is Salzburg Central Station (Salzburg Hbf), a stop for ICE and IC long distance trains operated by Deutsche Bahn and the Austrian Federal Railways (ÖBB).

By public transport

From the train station: Buses # 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6 take you directly to our hotel. Your point to get off is *Kongresshaus*. Duration: approx. 5 min. From the airport: Bus # 2 takes you directly to the hotel. Your point to get off is *Kongresshaus*. Duration approx. 30 min.

By taxi

From the train station: Duration about 3 min, costs approx. Euro 7,- depending on traffic and time of day. From the airport: Duration about 15 min, costs approx. Euro 20,- depending on traffic and time of day.

By car

Take the exit *Salzburg Mitte* – at the sign take the turn towards *Zentrum* and go straight ahead. After approx. 1,25 miles you will cross the river *Salzach* on the *Lehenbrücke*. Turn right on the 1st traffic light after the bridge. Pass a train bridge and turn into the 3rd street on the left hand side (*Auerspergstrasse*). Next street to the left again (*Rainerstrasse*). You will find us on the right side of the street.
